What is the Bishop's Appeal?

The Bishop's Appeal is the annual fundraising campaign conducted by the Catholic Foundation to support the ministries of the Diocese of Green Bay that reach out to our parishes, schools, families and individuals. Distributions from the Appeal:

- 20% Catholic Charities
- 20% Education
- 14% Ministry Formation
- 14% Stewardship & Pastoral Services
- 13% New Evangelization
- 9% Bishop's Appeal Expenses
- 5% Living Justice
- 3% Divine Worship
- 2% The Compass Newspaper

Who is a good Witness Speaker?

In any given parish, people who regularly benefit from the Appeal include members from Parish or Finance Councils, catechists, deacons, any lay minister, or those who have attended parish or diocesan speaker programs.


An effective speaker will

Witness Speaker <u>Outline</u>

Introduce yourself - why are you here? Example: Good morning, I'm Tom Smith, and have been a parishioner here at (church name) for XX years. I'd like to share with you today my thoughts on the Bishop's Appeal, how it benefits me, our parish, and people of the greater diocese.

It also funds countless <u>speaker series and</u> <u>programs</u> which inspire people to grow their faith.

Appeal Benefits People Throughout Diocese

Parishes benefit greatly from the Bishop's Appeal, and so do many other people in the diocese. For example, Catholic Charities receives 20% of the Appeal distributions. This funding is significant to their counseling efforts in personal budgeting, individual and family counseling, and adoption. The Appeal helps Catholic Charities assist those who need it the most!
