For Amanda, she knows first-hand the fear and pain of domestic abuse. She and her three children lived that nightmare for many years.




When Amanda left her abuser, she found herself in severe debt. She contacted Catholic Charities Financial Health Program for help and guidance.

our parishes and Catholic schools and is strengthened through diocesan departments like the Department of Education and Catholic Charities.


