Pastors, Pastoral Leaders and Parish Staff,

For the past few years, www.newcatholics.org has been kept active so parishes could use the parish member list manager tool on this site. This is because the Catholic Foundation does not have access to data within the ParishSOFT database, and ParishSOFT is unable whatsoever to sync with their fundraising database. Although attempts were made to connect these two databases, they were unsuccessful. The list manager tool is the only way for the Foundation to receive these critical parishioner updates.

Maintaining up-to-date data with the Catholic Foundation is critical to helping parishioners receive The Compass Newspaper all-household mailing, Bishop's Appeal mailings, and Bishop Ricken's Christmas letter. It removes deceased parishioners from receiving these mailings. Having a complete, updated list helps your parish reach its Bishop's Appeal goal.

Because there is no other use for www.newcatholics.org at this time, the Foundation was encouraged to create and move this tool to their website at www.catholicfoundationgb.org. And, over the past year, has created a new list interface and began beta-testing it with 27 parishes. The test results have been positive, and it is now ready to be used by all parishes.

If your parish is not currently using the new list manager tool on the Foundation site, please contact Tammy Danz at the Catholic Foundation to receive a login and password. Once you receive the login information, visit www.catholicfoundationgb.org, and click List Manager Login on the left-hand sidebar menu. If your parish has not already, we would ask you to begin using the new list manager tool located at www.catholicfoundationgb.org by Friday, June 17, 2016.
