## Key Talking Points for Homily or Announcement

- The 2015 Bishop's Appeal is underway. Here at <<parish name>>, this year we have received \_\_\_\_\_ gifts totaling \$ \_\_\_\_\_ toward the Bishop's Appeal.
- This weekend, we would like to challenge 10 people to give to the Bishop's Appeal who did not make a gift last year.
- A \$100 gift makes a tremendous impact on many ministries:
  - \$20 helps Catholic Charities provide counseling to individuals who need guidance.
  - \$19 supports religious education in our Catholic schools and parishes.
  - \$15 provide training in Ministry Formation so people can receive training to become leaders in our parish as Deacons, lay ministers, youth ministers and religious educators, and business managers.
  - \$14 helps Stewardship & Pastoral Services reach out to support the disabled, deaf, elderly and homebound. They also assist with parish planning, Hispanic outreach, and the mission in the Dominican Republic.
  - \$14 provides support for the New Evangelization as they share vibrant programming with people
    of all ages, inspiring their faith journey. RCIA, Encounter for Young Adults, Girlfriends in God,
    and campus ministries all receive funding from the Bishop's Appeal.
  - The remaining \$18 helps a wide variety of ministries such as Family Life and Marriage preparation, Respect Life activities, Catholic Social Justice, and The Compass newspaper.
