Dear Pastors and Pastoral Leaders:

The kickoff weekend for our annual **Seminarian Collection** is fast approaching. This is the second year the collection will be conducted through a direct mail appeal. There are no baskets to pass, and no envelopes to sort. **Your communication and support at the parish level is still the biggest factor to a successful campaign.** The renewal of the priesthood is underway in our diocese. This was evident as the Cathedral was packed on ordination day. Our seminarians are on fire about the mission of the diocese as well. Last year's collection reached an unprecedented \$739,000. This still does not cover our entire annual budget for vocations, but it sure is hopeful and I appreciate your help with this mission.

- **The collection is 100% direct mail.**
- **Please utilize the bulletin announcements, especially for the kickoff weekend.**
- **Even if you do not have a seminarian speaker the 1<sup>st</sup> weekend of August, it is imperative every parish highlight the collection during the kickoff weekend. We want all of the people to be prepared for Bishop Ricken's letter to arrive in their mailboxes so they may discern how they can make an impact.**
