



They had a vegetarian dinner, watched a Disney movie, "The Emperor's New Groove," to embrace the concept of giving to others, and conducted a collection to adopt a llama and support the Community of St. Paul in Vacas, Bolivia. A llama provides the community with milk and wool. "I wish to express our thanks and appreciation for the generous donation to support our Adopt a Llama project in Cochabamba, Bolivia," said Fr. Javier Guativa.

The 16 young adults exceeded their goal and raised \$195.00. In addition to the llama, they also purchased a bicycle for a catechist, who often travels 20 miles between villages, to teach the Word of the Lord in the Archdiocese of Tabora, Tanzania.

Many World Mission Services programs are available and provide students, teachers, families and faith communities with a greater awareness of the needs of our world. The llama project sponsored by the Community of St. Paul, participates in the Missionary Cooperation Plan, a program of the Pontifical Mission Society held each summer to raise funds for their home mission.



ack in 1871, the raging Peshtigo Fire destroyed everything in the area surrounding the Shrine of our Lady of Good Help, but the grounds at the chapel and buildings remain untouched, including the land consecrated to the Virgin Mary.

Pilgrims come year-round to this humble Shrine, basking in the warmth of Mary's open arms. Over time the Shrine grounds were improved. The National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help is rapidly growing as a site for pilgrims from around the world. Friends of the Shrine helped establish endowments and remembered the Shrine in their will. The Catholic Foundation is proud to oversee the fundraising efforts of the Shrine and help maintain its beauty for those devoted to Mary.

od has heard the prayers of the faithful in our Diocese, and through the Holy Spirit, we have 25 men committed to Christ and preparing to serve us as future priests. This tremendous blessing comes with great responsibility. It takes significant financial resources to guide these men through their formation in seminary. "I am grateful for the support I received from the Seminarian Collection. Your help made my path to priesthood happen," said Fr. Michael Thiel.

The Seminarian Collection provides funding for tuition, room and board, insurance, the Vocations department and other related expenses. The 2015 Seminarian Collection raised more than \$860,000. "Thank you for your support of my priestly journey through the Seminarian Collection," said Fr. Scott Valentyn. Several Catholic Foundation endowments also provide support to these men.

Hispanic Couples Seek to Strengthen Harriage and Pamily Hinistries

n September 2015, Pope Francis made his first papal visit to the U.S. during the World Meeting of Families in Philadelphia. More than a million people attended, including a large group from the Diocese of Green Bay.

The Catholic Foundation sponsored twelve Hispanic individuals who had a special purpose for their visit.

"There is a real need for Hispanics in our diocese to have our own marriage and family ministries. Language and cultural differences get in the way. And families today have so many challenges," said Juanita Fiscal, St. Willebrord parishioner.

The Hispanic families found wonderful inspiration in the speakers they heard and the people they met. Their first goal was to implement Hispanic Marriage Preparation classes. They worked with Peg VandeHey, who recently retired as the Family and Married Life Coordinator from the Diocese of Green Bay.

"We are bringing in a facilitator who will train this local group to help Hispanic couples prepare for the sacrament of marriage. Hopefully each parish with Hispanic families in our diocese will be able to offer marriage preparation in Spanish, and ultimately marriage enrichment classes in Spanish," said Peg VandeHey.

Juanita and her fellow pilgrims were grateful for the opportunity to attend the Philadelphia pilgrimage. "It was a once in a lifetime chance to see Pope Francis. It was a beautiful experience to walk together with other pilgrims, and to help each other. Through this experience, we hope to help Hispanic families draw closer to the Church," said Jaunita.

lanned giving is the act of making a charitable contribution where the method and timing benefit both the recipient and the contributor. The recipient can make long-range plans while relying on a dependable source for future funding. And the donor can reap numerous benefits: income tax incentives, guaranteed lifetime income, reduction or elimination of estate taxes, and the satisfaction of making an important charitable gift to a worthy cause, to name just a few. The possible ways of financing a planned gift are nearly limitless. They include:

Charitable Will Bequest — Bequeath gifts of real estate, cash, or other property as a last will and testament with the knowledge that it will benefit a charitable cause.

Charitable Living Will — Provide for eventual gifts or real estate, cash or other property knowing that all or part of the assets may be returned upon request.

Charitable Gift Annuity — Receive fixed annual payments for life which, for a period of time, may be partially free of taxes as well as an initial income tax reduction.

Charitable Remainder Trusts — May bypass capital gains tax at the time the trust is created, and may receive federal estate tax savings.

Charitable Lead Trust — Transfer assets to heirs with little or no real estate and gift taxes.

Life Insurance Policies — After a policy is no longer needed for its intended use, feel the satisfaction of giving to a charitable beneficiary.

Endowment Life Insurance Policies — Make a charitable gift to an organization which purchases policy in donor's name. When policy becomes self-funding, it is then designated to a beneficiary consistent with donor's wishes.


