






Bishop's Appeal


Year after year, we witness the tremendous care people extend to others through gifts to the Bishop's Appeal. Thanks to funding provided through the Appeal, people like Deacon Ernesto Gonzalez are trained and formed in the diaconate, engaged couples attend Marriage Preparation classes, and the faith journey of young adults is inspired through Encounter worship sessions.

The Bishop's Appeal is an annual fundraising campaign conducted by the Catholic Foundation to benefit the ministries and services of the Diocese of Green Bay. These ministries help form and train lay ministers, and supports Catholic schools and religious education. Through the generosity of the people of northeastern Wisconsin, the 2015 Bishop's Appeal raised more than \$5.6 million.











World Mission Services

Life is very challenging for 1,000 young girls at Stella Maris Boarding School in Uganda. Their living conditions are primitive. There is no running water, electricity is scarce, and latrines are holes in the ground. Fortunately, they are cared for by the Little Sisters of St. Francis of Assisi, who continually improve their lives.

During the Missionary Cooperation Appeal they raised \$9,000 to install a water collection system at the motherhouse. Through the Projects Available Booklet, they raise funds to farm chickens and pigs.

The World Missions office provides support to many missionaries across the globe through other activities such as Catholic Relief Services, and the Pontifical Mission Societies.

Students Attend March for Life in Washington D.C.

Imagine spending 17 hours on a bus crammed full of students in the middle of winter. The bus is buzzing with conversation and brimming with excitement. These proud students will stand before the nation voicing their opinions about the value of life.

Torey Gostas attended her fifth annual March for Life in January 2015. She is one of twelve diocesan Core Team Leaders to oversee 120 high school students attending the pilgrimage.

"I believe we are the generation that will change the hearts of people in this world, and overturn Roe v. Wade. I am passionately pro-life, and we need to share the pro-life message everywhere we go. Not just for the right to life of the unborn, but for the elderly, the unwanted, and those who feel they have no purpose in this world," says Gostas.

Thanks to a grant from the Advancing the Mission Evangelization Endowment, leaders were trained to evangelize and give witness talks to students about joining the pilgrimage. Additionally, students in need of financial aid received scholarships from the Monica Meyer Fund.

Emmaus Candidates Learn the Ministry of Leading Prayer

In the Gospel of John, Jesus tells His disciples to "love one another." These words resonate with candidates in the diocesan Emmaus program who are on the path to work in pastoral care, liturgy, faith formation, youth ministry, and parish business management. During their training they come to live fully with Christ, and learn to share His love with one another.

Paula Rieder shares her love of Jesus daily. After volunteering in ministry for 14 years, she completed her Emmaus journey and is following her true calling as Coordinator of Pastoral Ministry at St. Raphael Parish in Oshkosh.

One of Paula's classes was called "The Ministry of Leading Prayer." Here, Paula found prayer to be a powerful component in her formation. She, along with 18 other candidates, completed this course, and will serve parishes and nursing homes as Lay Leaders of Prayer in nine different prayer rites.

Emmaus candidates receive grant funding from the Advancing the Mission Leadership Development Endowment, as well as from the Bishop's Appeal. This funding provides financial assistance to complete the rigorous Emmaus certification program.

Paula is grateful for her formation experiences and instructors. She loves reaching out to share the love of Christ with others through word, prayer and Eucharist. "The financial aid I received from the Catholic Foundation was very helpful. Through the Ministry of Leading Prayer training, I learned that prayer is not only in what we say, but in how we move — it's a full experience."

Planned Giving

Planned giving is the act of making a charitable contribution where the method and timing benefit both the recipient and the contributor. The recipient can make long-range plans while relying on a dependable source for future funding. And the donor can reap numerous benefits: income tax incentives, guaranteed lifetime income, reduction or elimination of estate taxes, and the satisfaction of making an important charitable gift to a worthy cause, to name just a few. The possible ways of financing a planned gift are nearly limitless. They include:

Charitable Will Bequest — Bequeath gifts of real estate, cash, or other property as a last will and testament with the knowledge that it will benefit a charitable cause.

Charitable Living Will — Provide for eventual gifts or real estate, cash or other property knowing that all or part of the assets may be returned upon request.

Charitable Gift Annuity — Receive fixed annual payments for life which, for a period of time, may be partially free of taxes as well as an initial income tax reduction.

Charitable Remainder Trusts — May bypass capital gains tax at the time the trust is created, and may receive federal estate tax savings.

Charitable Lead Trust — Transfer assets to heirs with little or no estate and gift taxes.

Life Insurance Policies — After a policy is no longer needed for its intended use, feel the satisfaction of giving to a charitable beneficiary.

Endowment Life Insurance Policies — Make a charitable gift to an organization which purchases a policy in the donor's name. When policy becomes self-funding, it is then designated to a beneficiary consistent with donor's wishes.

Gifts of Appreciated Property — Includes real estate, timber rights, personal property, pension or retirement funds, stocks and marketable securities, works of art and special collections.




