

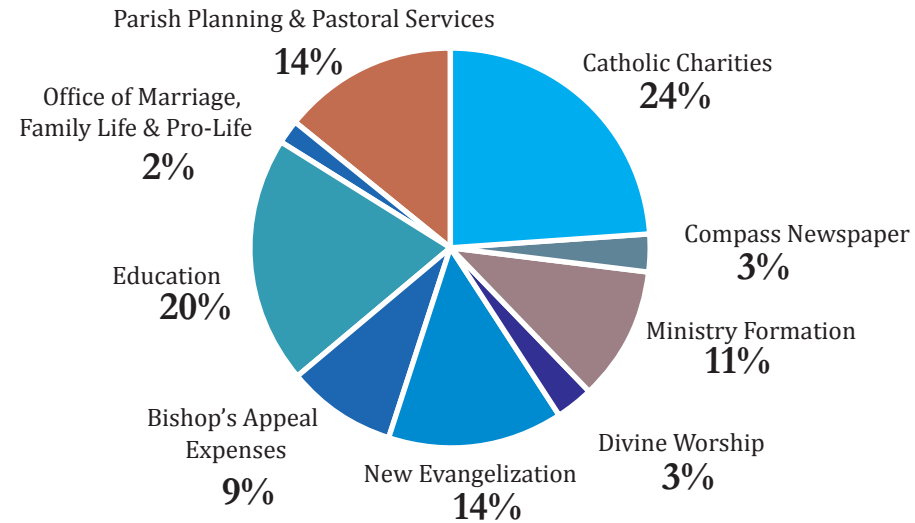

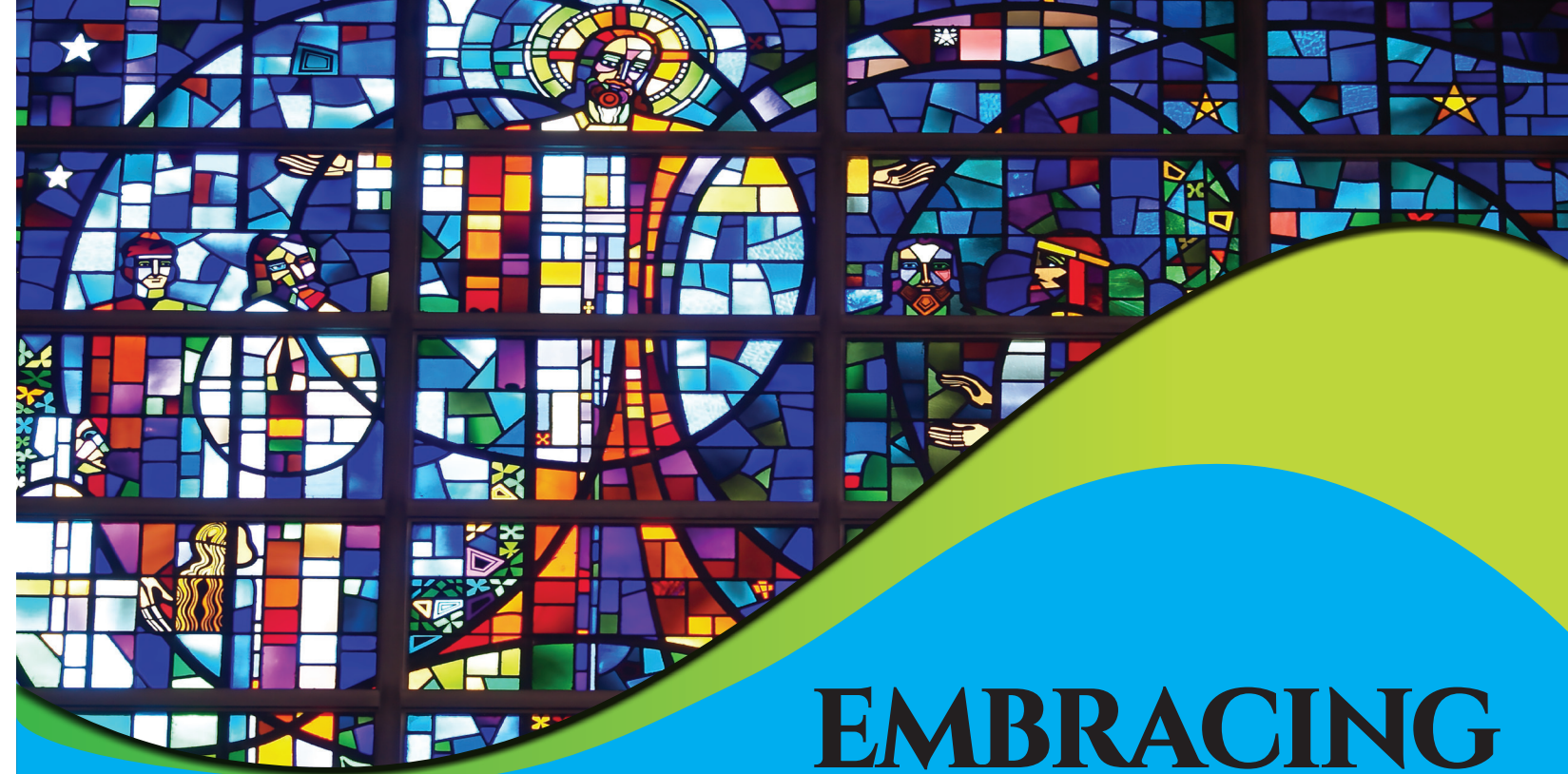
OUR PROMISE TO YOU
