THE VOCATIONS GOAL

By 2025, we will call forth and form 30 seminarians to be missionary leaders in the priesthood.

Having 30 seminarians would mean that in any given year, we would ordain three to five priests, which is what we believe we will need in order to meet the pastoral needs of our Diocese. There is significant work ahead, as we work to build families and communities of discipleship that discover, follow, worship and share Jesus with others.
