STRENGTHENING OUR PARISHES \$30,000,000

"In our parishes, the people of God welcome others and, through our communion with Christ and one another, strive to build a family of love." – Bishop David L. Ricken

Our 156 parishes are the spiritual homes of nearly 300,000 Catholics across 16 counties in northeastern Wisconsin. In these communities, we join together as a family of faith to pray, celebrate the Eucharist and witness the Good News of Jesus Christ.

But many of our parishes are in need of renewal of their ministries, programs and buildings. We must ensure these sacred spaces are able to provide opportunities to encounter Christ as well as send forth people to reach out to those who are no longer practicing but want to reengage with their faith as well as those who are seeking a faith home.

The one by One campaign will allow our parishes to invest in the mission of the Church, to more fully serve the spiritual needs of their parishioners and to share Christ within their communities. The largest share of gifts to the campaign will be directed to strengthening parishes, with 50 percent of the funds parishes collect remaining in parishes to meet the local needs they identify.





To further strengthen our parishes, and our Church, the one by One campaign will:

Grow Priestly Vocations


Planting the seeds of a vocation requires vibrant ministries for our youth and young adults. We must also support men discerning the priesthood, seminarians in formation and priests from their ordination to retirement.

Help Others Discover Christ

Our parishes and schools need well-formed leaders, ministries and programs to educate us in the faith and to inspire us to reach out and invite others to join us on our journey to the Kingdom of God.

Bring Christ To Those In Need

As Catholics, we are called to promote the social teachings of the Church, especially those relating to social justice. Access to ministries is key to helping our vulnerable brothers and sisters.





Although God continues to call men to the priesthood and women to religious life, the noisiness of today's world can obstruct this message so vital in our Church.

A shortage of priests has left many parishes in our Diocese without a pastor. Bishop Ricken has set a goal of having a minimum of 30 men in seminary formation by 2025. Ensuring that men and women continue to hear and answer God's call is a top priority for the one by One campaign.

Campus Ministry

Campus ministry forms intentional disciples and raises up vocations to the priesthood, religious life and marriage. Improving the gathering and worship spaces and programs at the University of Wisconsin in Green Bay and in Oshkosh will help connect students to their faith during these formative years.

Camp Tekakwitha

For nearly 100 years, our young people have encountered Christ amidst the beauty of God's creation at Camp Tekakwitha. Our campaign will ensure future generations of children are able to grow in faith and fellowship through this vital ministry.



Men in Discernment and Priests

Creating a Priestly Vocation and Education Endowment will support the increasing number of seminarians in formation as well as candidates discerning the priesthood during a pre-seminary Kairos Year at the Holy Name of Jesus House of Formation in Green Bay. We will also provide continuing education to our priests, whose ministerial skills are often challenged in an ever-changing world.

Care for Senior Priests

Our campaign will bolster the Diocesan Priests Retirement Fund, ensuring financial security for the men who have dedicated their lives to serving us.

An investment in our parishes and schools is essentially an investment in the future of our Church. Ensuring the vitality of these diocesan institutions and the dedicated people who give them life through their service and dedication will result in families, young adults and children who are inspired to share Christ — in the real world and digital spaces they gather.

Families

The religious education of children is most successful when their families are also engaged and active in their faith. The one by One campaign will help us evangelize and form marriages and families into households that discover, follow, worship and share Christ with others — building stronger marriages, engaging parents in the life of the Church and supporting them as they raise their children in today's challenging world.



Young Adults

We must be dynamically present in the online spaces where young adults gather meaningfully as well as enhance the ways in which we engage with them in person. A new digital ministry will allow staff members to evangelize this important demographic. Our campaign will also ensure the communities currently engaging young adults reflect the breadth of cultures that enliven our Diocese, and that parishes are equipped to reach out to these future leaders who will continue to grow our Church.



Religious Education

Our parishes serve as many as 16,500 students a year through religious education and youth ministry. Inspired catechectical leaders are key to teaching the Catholic faith to the next generation, and our campaign will increase regional opportunities for in-person development as well as bilingual online formation.

Given the significant growth our Diocese has experienced in its Hispanic, Native American, Hmong, Black and other ethnic populations, we will make their specific catechetical needs a priority with specialized materials, training and outreach to meet them where they are.



Emerging Technology

The coronavirus pandemic proved the power of technology for good. The Diocese plans to build on this new reality, where real connections happen virtually as well as in person. Having technologically advanced spaces — in the pastoral center in Green Bay and online — will allow Bishop Ricken and diocesan staff to connect more efficiently with parish leaders and parishioners throughout the Diocese.

The one by One campaign will also create a fund to ensure the Diocese remains current on the technology front.

Parish and School Leaders

Well-formed, dynamic and faith-filled leaders are essential to inspiring our children on their sacramental journey. Our campaign will assist parishes and schools with short-term grants to help fill open positions with individuals who have the desire and skill set to passionately serve the Church.



Catholic Schools

Families who choose a Catholic education expect Catholic schools to be strong in both Catholic character and academic excellence. To form students in mind and spirit, the campaign will enrich staff members to encourage discipleship, enhance curriculum offerings and increase marketing and outreach. We will also provide partial grants to schools facing significant repairs, maintenance and upgrades to advance learning.



Tuition Assistance

Our 54 Catholic elementary and high schools form thousands of children and their families in the faith each year. But affordability is a critical issue for families who may not qualify for needbased scholarships — and could be problematic in the future for families, and schools, relying on vouchers should the state of Wisconsin ever choose to discontinue this program. A newly created endowed scholarship program will provide tuition support for students in Catholic elementary and high schools.







BRINGING CHRIST TO THOSE IN NEED

The joy of the Gospel is often most needed in spaces where people find themselves alone, suffering and without hope. As Catholics, we are called to seek out the stranger, heal the sick and comfort the weary so all may know a deeper relationship with Christ.

The one by One campaign will promote the social teachings of the Church, especially those relating to justice and dignity, through Catholic Charities and complementing diocesan programs that bring healing and peace through pastoral outreach.

Catholic Charities

Catholic Charities is transitioning to a new service model to work with and within our communities to bring its mental health, adoption, financial health and immigration and refugee services to more people in need.

Healing Ministries

Our campaign will develop teams of healing ministers in parishes and increase the number of chaplains serving in our hospitals, long-term health care facilities and prisons.

Rural Parishes

A new endowment will provide grants to rural parishes to engage young people through faith formation and social outreach, and provide ongoing adult faith formation, leadership development and social opportunities.

Our Homeless Neighbors

A new endowment will award grants to homeless shelters and service providers at work within the Diocese.

Two by two, we will journey as "disciples on the way," eagerly discovering, following, worshipping and sharing Jesus with all those we meet.


