***one by One* Catholic School Facilities Grant**

Purpose

This grant was created by the *one by One* campaign to provide support and assistance to benefit Pre-K through Grade 12 Catholic school facilities within the Diocese of Green Bay.

- Requests must indicate significant repairs, maintenance and upgrade needed at the Catholic school to advance learning
- Requests may strengthen school technology to support hybrid teaching in classrooms as well as introduce innovative instructional models. These requests may provide opportunities for schools to band together to increase offerings that would be cost prohibitive if accomplished on their own.

Important Things to Note Prior to Applying

- This grant is intended to provide seed grants and not fully-fund any particular project, but may fully fund a project on a case-by-case basis.
- An application must be submitted for each facility by an employee of the organization who owns the facility. A parish trustee may also submit an application for parishes who own the school building.
- Only one project may be submitted per application (Project examples: roof repairs, heating/boiler replacement, replacement of school windows)
- An application may be submitted for projects completed within the previous academic year.
- For capital projects and/or fundraising efforts of \$100,000 or more, diocesan proxies are required for each. Please direct proxy questions to FP@gbdioc.org at the Diocese of Green Bay.

 - Application window: July 1 – September 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes:
 - June
 - November
