



Advancing the Mission Evangelization Grant

Purpose

This grant was created by the Advancing the Mission campaign to provide support for the Evangelization Department of the Diocese of Green Bay and to help support Diocesan-wide, vicariate, parish cluster, and/or parish programs for:

- Worship
- Spirituality
- Sacred music
- Youth and young adult ministry
- Marriage preparation
- Family life
- Baptism preparation
- Campus ministry
- Retreat operations
- Activities of the Right of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) programs

Important Things to Note Prior to Applying

- Programs that have a free alternative are not typically funded (i.e. Hallow would not be funded since there are similar free alternative apps)
- Speakers must be approved by the Diocese of Green Bay prior to applying for a grant for an event. Please click [here](#) for more information.
- Projects must be planned with defined dates and budget information included on the grant application

Important Dates

- Grant cycle opens: October 1
- Grant cycle closes: December 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes: Spring
- If Awarded, Grant Checks Mailed: Before June 30

Typical Applicants and Projects within the Diocese of Green Bay

- Diocese of Green Bay
- Parishes
- Catholic Schools
- Sample project requests include speakers at parish and school events, campus ministry programs, parish and school retreats, sacred music/worship programs and vacation bible camp funding. Please note Bibles are not typically covered by the grant.

Average Grant Awards

- Average awards are between \$1,000 - \$3,000.

Criteria upon which your grant application may be considered include:

- The application advances the mission of the Church of Green Bay, meets a priority need for your organization, is collaborative with other parishes/schools/organizations and the requested project does not duplicate another program.

The following types of requests are generally not covered:

- Structural building and capital projects, technology, books, travel costs or food/refreshments.
