The Catholic Foundation makes annual grants from areas of interest funds and designated endowments that benefit the services and ministries that serve those who are poor and homeless within the Diocese of Green Bay, support services that impact children and youth, and other areas of need.

Please apply for the *one by One* Homeless Services Grant for funding requests to benefit homeless shelters and homeless service providers with programs and ministries serving homeless populations.

Important Dates

- Grant cycle opens: October 1
- Grant cycle closes: December 1
- Applicant Notification of Outcomes: Spring
- If Awarded, Grant Checks Mailed: Before June 30

Typical Applicants and Projects within the Diocese of Green Bay

- Parishes
- Homeless shelters (Please apply for the *one by One* Homeless Services Grant)
- Food pantries
- Sample project requests include feeding the hungry programs and food pantry assistance programs.

Average Grant Awards

- Typical awards vary from \$250 - \$1,500
