- Sample project requests include programs that educate pregnant women about their babies, Masses for loss of children, and programs that promote life.

Average Grant Awards

Typically awards up to \$1,000 per organization

Criteria upon which your grant application may be considered include:

The application advances the mission of the Church of Green Bay, meets a priority need for your
organization, is collaborative with other parishes/schools/organizations and the requested project
does not duplicate another program.

The following types of requests are generally not covered:

Structural building and capital projects, technology, books, travel costs or food/refreshments.
